Clinical Specimen Storage and Shipping Guidance

If shipping is delayed

Clinical specimens for testing at the Waycross Public Health Laboratory (WPHL) should be shipped within 24 hours of collection by courier. When shipping must be delayed (e.g., inclement weather, courier closures), guidelines are given below on proper transport conditions of common specimen types.

Measles IgG	≤ 9 days	☆ DRY ICE REQUIRED ※
Rubella IgG	≤ 3 days	★ DRY ICE REQUIRED ★
VZV IgG	≤ 7 days	☆ DRY ICE REQUIRED ☆
Syphillis	≤ 5 days	☆ DRY ICE REQUIRED ☆
Mumps IgG	≤ 9 days	☆ DRY ICE REQUIRED ☆
Rabies	As soon as possible	
Trichomonas vaginalis	Varies by specimen type, see LSM for details	
Chlamydia/Gonorrhea	Varies by specimen type, see LSM for details	
SARS CoV-2	Varies by specimen type, see LSM for details	

If shipping immediately

Refrigerate specimens 2-8°C post collection.
Specimens must be received cold (2-8°C) on frozen ice packs within the number of hours/days as indicated in the chart from time of collection.

 ≤ -70°C post collection.
 Ship overnight via
 commercial courier on
 dry ice.
- Freeze specimens at
 ≤ -20°C post collection.
 Ship overnight via
 commercial courier on
 dry ice.
- Store and ship at
 ambient temperature.
 Specimens must be
 received within the
 number of hours/days as
 indicated in the chart
 from time of collection.
