**NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING**  
**Repeal of Public Health Regulation**  
**Chapter 511-4-3 “Mosquito Control Measures On Impounded Waters”**


Please take note that the Department of Public Health proposes to repeal Chapter 511-4-3 “Mosquito Control Measures On Impounded Waters”, pursuant to its authority under O.C.G.A. § 31-2A-6.

This Chapter was originally promulgated in 1965, and has not been enforced by Public Health in many years. Since the creation of the Environmental Protection Division of the Department of Natural Resources in 1972, responsibility for impounded waters has rested with that agency. The Department of Public Health therefore regards this Chapter to be obsolete.
