

Once you have logged in you will be presented with the main screen. All reports entered via your userid will be displayed at the bottom of the screen and a search option is also available to narrow down the results. The Main Screen is also used for adding new cases and editing existing.

Functionality of the Main Screen (Overview)

To add a new case to the registry click on the Add New Patient to Registry	link [1]	
To view or edit an existing case click on the plus ⊞ sign [2]		
To Search for an existing case, fill in the Search criteria and click on the	Search / Refresh	link [3]
To Logout of the registry, click on the Log Out link [4]		

Case Status

Once a case has been reported, Staff at the Georgia Department of Public Health will review the record and assign it a status [5]. If it appears information has been left off or is deemed inaccurate you may be contacted for follow up to supply additional or verify information.

New Report – The case has recently been created and awaiting DPH staff to assign a status **Under Review** – DPH staff are currently reviewing the case

Confirmed – The case has met all criteria to be counted as a case

On-hold – DPH staff have reviewed the case and awaiting additional information from the reporting facility.

Deleted – The case did not meet minimum criteria or the case has been reported before.

Sent to OASIS – The case has been sent to OASIS (Online Analytical Statistical Information System) For more information please go to the OASIS website https://oasis.state.ga.us




To add a new case to the registry click on the Add New Patient to Registry link




While the case remains with a status of "New Report" you are able to edit the record and re-save.

To narrow down the list of displayed cases, a search option is available to narrow down the list. The list only shows cases report by you.





Definitions:

ADRD Staging: Early (Mild): Decreased knowledge of recent occasions or current events; impaired ability to perform challenging mental arithmetic- to count backward from 75 by 7s; decreased capacity for complex tasks (e.g., paying bills and managing finances); reduced memory of personal history; may be subdued and withdrawn, especially in socially or mentally challenging situations; unable to recall such important details as their current address, telephone number or the name of high school from which they graduated.

Middle (moderate): Lose awareness of recent experiences, events and surroundings; recollect personal history imperfectly, generally recall their own name; occasionally forget name of spouse or primary caregiver but distinguish familiar from unfamiliar faces; need help getting dressed; experience disruption of normal sleep/waking cycle; need help with toileting; increasing urinary or fecal incontinence; experience personality changes and behavioral symptoms, suspiciousness and delusions, hallucinations, or compulsive, repetitive behaviors such as hand-wringing; may wander and become lost.

Late (severe): Lose capacity for recognizable speech, although words or phrases may occasionally be uttered; need help with eating and toileting; general incontinence of urine; lose ability to walk without assistance, inability to sit without support, inability to smile, and hold head up; reflexes become abnormal and muscles grow rigid; swallowing is impaired.
