RE: Printing an Updated Georgia Medic License

Date: June 1, 2016

The Office of EMS and Trauma (OEMS) has completed the process of matching our license cycle to match that of the National Registry of EMTs (NREMT). These steps included changing the expiration date for all licensees **who are not nationally registered** to 3/31/2017 and then changing the expiration date for all licensees **who are nationally registered** to either 3/31/2017 or 3/31/2018 (depending on the NREMT expiration).

Now that this process is complete, we have created an online method that you can use to print a new Georgia license. If clicking the link does not work, copy and paste the link above into your web browser.

Since all Georgia EMS licenses have been extended until either 3/31/2017 or 3/31/2018, the opening date for renewals has also changed.

### **Renewal Dates for Licenses Expiring on 3/31/2017**

Renewal Opens:	10/1/2016
Renewal Closes:	3/31/2017
Late Renewal Opens:	4/1/2017
Late Renewal Closes:	9/30/2017

*Late renewals require a late penalty of \$75 (\$150 total fee) and all other license requirements must have been met prior to 4/1/2017. While late renewals are allowed, the medic's license will lapse and will remain lapsed until the license has been renewed through the late renewal process.*
