

## Georgia Department of Public Health WIC Dietetic Internship Program

### Goals and Outcome Measures

**DPH WIC Dietetic Internship Program Goal 1:** The DPH WIC Dietetic Internship Program will prepare graduates to be competent at an entry level through high quality educational offerings.

#### Outcome Measures – Goal 1:

- Over a five-year period, 80% of the dietetic internship program graduates will pass the CDR Registration Examination on the first attempt.
- 50% of dietetic interns achieve an average ranking of 3.5 or above (scale of 1-4) on core and community nutrition emphasis competencies.
- 90% of employers will rate dietetic internship program graduates as competent at entry level.

**DPH WIC Dietetic Internship Program Goal 2:** The DPH WIC Dietetic Internship Program will attract and retain well qualified candidates.

#### Outcome Measures – Goal 2:

- 90% of the interns will complete the program in 18 months or 150% time planned for completion.
- 80% of dietetic internship program graduates seeking employment will be employed within 90 days of graduation.

**DPH WIC Dietetic Internship Program Goal 3:** The DPH WIC Dietetic Internship Program will prepare graduates who will continue to practice in community nutrition care services in Georgia after program completion.

#### Outcome Measures - Goal 3:

- 80% of dietetic internship program graduates will indicate working/volunteering in nutrition within Georgia Department of Public Health two (2) years after program completion.
