
Formulas NOT Approved for Issuance in Georgia WIC



Similac Sensitive for Spit-Up

- Coming February 2012
- New Name = Similac for Spit-Up
- "EarlyShield" added to formulation and to the label
- Change will occur on all sizes/forms of the products
- More information as gets closer, but sample
 of "new" label on next slide





Nutramigen and Pregestimil Changes


- Coming in Mid- to Late December 2011
- Should be on most store shelves by early 2012
- "LIPIL" is being removed from both of the names but DHA and ARA will continue to be in both products
- The Peter Rabbit bunny is being removed from labels
- No label images available yet, but have requested copies of PDFs

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Nutramigen and Pregestimil Changes (cont.)

- Affected Products:
 - Nutramigen Enflora with LGG powder
 - All Nutramigen liquid products (ready-to-feed in all sizes plus concentrate)
 - Pregestimil powder and 2 fl oz ready-to-feed nursettes





999 Questionnaire Sent to Districts

 <u>Purpose</u>: to determine what special formula products were still commonly in use on 999 voucher codes

999 Questionnaire Sent to Districts (cont.) Discovered that we did not have single voucher code for "1-gallon or 2-half gallons of whole lactose free, or

- for "1-gallon or 2-half gallons of whole lactose free, or Acidophilus, or Acidophilus and Bifidum. No low fat milk. Least Expensive Brand." (For use **only** with children ages 12-23 months **or** older children/women in Food Package III.)
- Discovered that we did not have single voucher code for "1-32 fl oz ready-to-feed Nutramigen" either
