**RE:** Status of District Outreach Workers

This memorandum is in response to the question regarding the status of the District Outreach Workers for the remainder of FFY 2013 and FFY 2014. The financial picture for FFY 2014 is not clear at this time. Therefore, the status of the Outreach Worker positions for next fiscal year is uncertain. However, for FFY 2013, which ends September 30, 2013, funds will support the continuation of the Outreach Workers positions in your Districts.

Once we know our funding situation, the State Agency will contact the Districts within a 30 day window and will provide information on the need to down size or eliminate the Outreach Worker Program. Increasing caseload in the Georgia WIC Program is very important. Outreach Workers are the key to reaching moms and children that are eligible and ensuring that they receive WIC benefits for their families.
