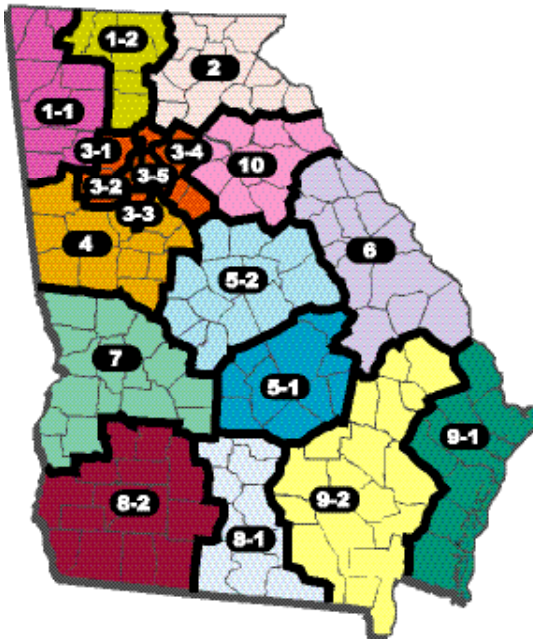

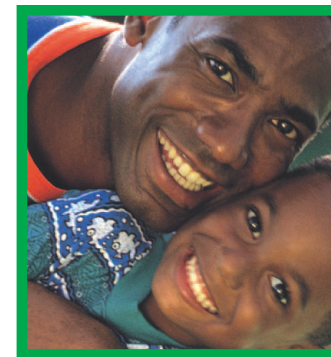

Health Services for Georgia's Children and Youth with Special Health Care Needs

What is CMS?

Children's Medical Services (CMS) is a Georgia Department of Public Health (DPH) program that provides or arranges specialty medical/health care services for eligible children with chronic medical conditions in Georgia.

CMS services are family-centered, culturally/linguistically competent and community-based.



How does CMS help eligible children & families?

The CMS program:

- Promotes healthy growth & development
- Helps to prevent further complications often related to chronic medical conditions
- Coordinates comprehensive care

Who is eligible for CMS?

Children & youth, birth to age 21 who:

- Live in Georgia
- Have an eligible medical condition
- Meet income eligibility



Where can children & youth receive CMS services?

- CMS services are available statewide in each of the 18 health districts in Georgia. (See back panel for complete list)

What are some examples of eligible medical conditions?

- Burns, cardiac, chronic lung (including asthma & cystic fibrosis)
- Craniofacial anomalies (including cleft lip and /or palate)
- Orthopedic & neuromuscular (including cerebral palsy, scoliosis, & amputations), diabetes mellitus, gastrointestinal disorders, and hearing loss
- Spina bifida, neurological and neurosurgical disorders (including epilepsy and hydrocephalus), and conditions affecting vision (cataracts, glaucoma, amblyopia & strabismus)



What services are available?

Working with the child's primary medical provider, CMS may provide or arrange for:

- Medical/diagnostic testing
- Specialty medical care, treatment, medications & supplies
- Care coordination to maximize use of community resources
- Referral to community resources
