Policy

The Breastfeeding Coordinator, Peer Counselor (PC) Supervisor, Lead Peer Counselor, or other designee is responsible for monitoring Peer Counselors' caseloads and documentation; observing their face to face and telephone contacts; and completing quality assurance surveys.

Purpose

To standardize consistency with peer counseling management of their roles and responsibilities.

Procedures

- I. Breastfeeding Coordinators, Peer Counselor Supervisors or Leads shall ensure that Peer Counselors':
 - A. Carry a caseload size that is 2 to 3 times their scheduled hours worked.
 - B. Have appropriate caseload ratio (i.e. prenatal versus postpartum) (See <u>Peer</u> Counselor Caseload Management Policy).
 - C. Contact participants within appropriate timeframes (See <u>Breastfeeding Peer</u> Counselor Policy)
 - D. Document in the Peer Counselor Database (PCDB) record
 - 1. Participants' concerns
 - 2. How they were educated
 - 3. Participants' breastfeeding goal
 - 4. Use of "Talking Points" for conversation guidance.
 - E. Addresses any follow up from the previous contact
 - F. Yield to Designated Breastfeeding Expert or skilled care (if applicable)
 - II. Breastfeeding Coordinators, Peer Counselor Supervisors or Leads shall ensure that each Peer Counselor have one face to face and one telephone observation per quarter. (See Peer Counselor Observation Checklist).
 - A. Maintain documentation that Peer Counselor staff received required quarterly observations. (See Continuing Education Documentation Log)
- III. Breastfeeding Coordinators, Peer Counselor Supervisors, or Leads shall ensure that random quality assurance participant surveys are completed quarterly as detailed below. (See Peer Counselor Participant Survey).

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- A. Five (5) percent of participants on the <u>Peer Counselor Database</u>'s "Recently Off Program" list from the previous quarter.
- B. Five (5) percent of participants on the "Peer Counselor Database's "Estimated Due Date (EDD)" list.
