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Ending the HIV Epidemic (EHE)

GOAL:

75% reduction in new HIV infections in 5 years and at least

90% reduction in 10 years. HHS will work with each community to establish local teams on the ground to tailor and implement strategies to:

Diagnose all people with HIV as early as possible.

Treat people with HIV rapidly and effectively to reach sustained viral suppression.



Prevent new HIV transmissions by using proven interventions, including pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) and syringe services programs (SSPs).

Respond quickly to potential HIV outbreaks to get needed prevention and treatment services to people who need them.

Did you know that DeKalb County ranks second in the state of Georgia regarding its HIV burden?


