Secure pediatric patients in an appropriate child restraint system. Every child, every time!



Consider a child's age and weight when determining an appropriate restraint system.



Drive cautiously at safe speeds observing traffic laws.



Ensure appropriate restraint systems are used by EMS providers and other occupants, including the patient.

DON'Ts 🔀





Transport a child on a parent's lap.



Transport a child in a child restraint seat on the benchseat or the CPR seat.



Transport children in their own safety seats if the seat was involved in a crash.



Leave monitoring devices or other equipment unsecured in a moving ambulance.



Drive at unsafe high speeds with rapid acceleration, deceleration, and turns.
