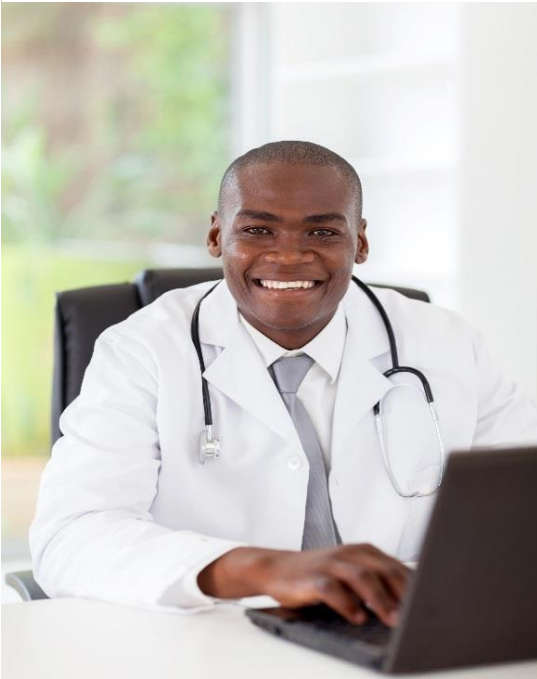


Tips for Health Care Providers in Georgia
