Keeping your card + PIN safe

<u> e</u>WIC card care

- Keep your card in a clean, dry place.
- Keep your card out of direct sunlight and away from magnets and electronics.

PIN safety

- Only share your PIN with someone you've given permission to use your card.
- Benefits will not be replaced if someone uses your PIN to purchase WIC foods without your permission to use the card.
- If you forget your PIN, or want to change it, call WIC Customer Service at **1.844.309.5653**.

PIN/Card replacement

• If your card is lost, stolen, damaged or if you need to replace your card, call WIC Customer Service right away or call your local WIC clinic.

What happens if I forgot my PIN or enter it wrong?

If you enter the **wrong PIN three times in a row**, your card will be locked. Here are the ways to unlock your card:

- Go to the www.WICConnect.com.
- Call WIC Customer Service.
- Wait until 12:01 a.m. the next day & your account will automatically unlock.

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Getting Started

Before you can begin using your eWIC card, you must **select a 4-digit Personal Identification Number (PIN)**.

Select a PIN

- Call WIC Customer Service, to set your pin: **1.844.309.5653**.
- You will need the **16-digit eWIC card number** along with the **name**, **date of birth** and **zip code** of the primary cardholder.
- Choose a **4-digit number** that is easy for you to remember but hard for others to guess.
- **DO NOT write your PIN** on your eWIC card or in your eWIC cardholder brochure.

Using your Card

You must have your **Georgia eWIC card with** you at the store to use your WIC benefits. You can use your eWIC card at **Georgia WIC** authorized retailers.

- Know your WIC food benefit balance when you go to the store.
- Use your Georgia WIC Approved Foods List to **check which foods are allowed**.

Omplete your purchase

- It is important to **swipe** your Georgia eWIC card **before** any other forms of payment are used. Any remaining balance can be paid with SNAP, cash or other forms of payment accepted by the store.
- Enter your 4-digit PIN when asked.

• Keep your receipt – it shows your benefit balance.

- Log on to www.WICConnect.com.
- Call WIC Customer Service.
- Visit a Georgia authorized WIC retailer and request a balance inquiry.

Understanding your benefits

It is important to know when you receive your benefits. **Do not throw away your eWIC card when all the benefits are used**. The same card and PIN are used every month.

🕑 Benefit availability

- Your benefits become **available** on the **Benefit Start Date at 12:01 a.m.** and **end at 11:59 p.m. on the Benefit End Date**.
- Benefits that have not been spent **DO NOT carry over** to the next benefit period.

Reading your receipt

Your grocery receipt will list the WIC food items you bought and the remaining WIC food benefits and expiration date. Here is an example:
