WHEN CAN YOU HAVE SEX? Do not have any type of sex (with or without protection) for at least 7 days after taking azithromycin or until you have completed a medical evaluation. Avoid any sexual contact (with or without protection) with individuals who have not been

ADVERSE EFFECTS? If you experience trouble breathing, swelling of your face, lips, tongue, or throat, hives or severe skin reaction after taking this medication, go to the emergency room immediately and take the container in which your medication came.

WHAT IS CHLAMYDIA?


Chlamydia is a sexually transmitted disease that can be easily cured with proper treatment.

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

It is important that you are treated for exposure to chlamydia promptly. Often chlamydia has no signs or symptoms, so most people don't know they are infected. Left untreated, chlamydia can lead to serious complications.

WHAT IS EXPEDITED PARTNER THERAPY (EPT)?

PARTNER THERAPY (EPT)? You are being offered expedited partner therapy (EPT), which allows sexual partners of individuals diagnosed with chlamydia to receive medications or prescriptions without having to see a healthcare provider.



WHAT IC THE MEDICATION

WHAT IS THE MEDICATION YOU ARE RECEIVING?
You are receiving an antibiotic called azithromycin to treat the infection. Be sure to take all of the medicine as prescribed for

it to be effective. IS THIS MEDICATION

You should not take this medication if you have ever had an allergic reaction (like a rash, hives, shortness of breath) to azithromycin (Zithromax), erythromycin, clarithromycin (Biaxin). If you are unsure about whether you have an allergy, or you have a serious, long-term illness like kidney, liver or heart disease, colitis or stomach problems, talk to your doctor before taking this medication.
