

GA Eligibility for Publicly Funded Vaccines Guide

This document provides guidance on choosing the most appropriate insurance status and coding for children and adults receiving vaccines from the Georgia State Department of Health.

Choosing Insurance Status and Codes for Children

Patient Status	Eligibility for Public Vaccine*	Eligibility Code & Description	Funding Code & Description
Any patient under 19 with private insurance	No	V01 NOT VFC Eligible	PHC70 Privately funded vaccine stock
American Indian/Alaska Native Child Child is less than 19 years old and is a member of a federally recognized tribe.	Yes Federal (VFC) vaccine eligible	V04 VFC eligible – American Indian/Alaska Native	VXC50 Publicly funded vaccine stock – VFC
Medicaid Child Child is less than 19 years old and is enrolled in Medicaid or Medicaid Managed Care.	Yes Federal (VFC) vaccine eligible	V02 VFC eligible – Medicaid/Medicaid Managed Care	VXC50 Publicly funded vaccine stock – VFC
Uninsured Child Child is less than 19 years old and does not have health insurance.	Yes Federal (VFC) vaccine eligible	V03 VFC eligible – Uninsured	VXC50 Publicly funded vaccine stock – VFC
Under-insured Child seen at a FQHC/RHC Child is less than 19 years old, is receiving care at a Federally Qualified Health Center/Rural Health Center (FQHC/RHC) and has insurance but insurance does not cover vaccines.	Yes Federal (VFC) vaccine eligibility only through FQHC/RHC providers	V05 VFC eligible – Underinsured at FQHC/RHC	VXC50 Publicly funded vaccine stock – VFC

Medicare Adult Adults are 19 years or older and are enrolled in Medicare.	No	V01 Medicare	PHC70 Privately funded vaccine stock
Un/Under-insured Adult seen at a Facility that has 317 State Supplied Adult Vaccines Adult is 19 or older, is receiving care at a facility that has 317-funded, state supplied adult vaccine, and does not have insurance or has insurance but insurance does not cover vaccines.	Yes State program eligible	V06 State program eligible (317) – Under/un-insured adults	VXC50 Publicly funded vaccine stock.
Un/Under-insured Adult Adult is 19 years or older and does not have insurance or has insurance, but insurance does not cover vaccines.	No	V01 Not public vaccine eligible	PHC70 Privately funded vaccine stock
Insured Adult Adult is 19 years or older and has insurance.	No	V01 Not public vaccine eligible	PHC70 Privately funded vaccine stock
COVID-19/Monkey Pox Eligible Patients	Yes Pandemic Eligibility	V01 Not public vaccine eligible	VXC50 Publicly funded vaccine stock
