HOPWA Program Goals


HOPWA Program in GA

- Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) receives HOPWA funding to serve 125 counties in GA that are mainly rural area.
 - DCA has funded 12 regional HOPWA Sponsors to cover its jurisdiction.
- City of Atlanta HOPWA program receives funding to cover 29-county Metro-Atlanta area.
- City of Augusta HOPWA program receives funding to cover 5
 Augusta-Richmond counties and 2 counties in South Carolina.





Who is Eligible?

- Households with income up to 80%Area Median Income
- Experienced financial Hardship due to COVID-19



Documents for Tenants

- Income document on every adult member
- Past due rent or utility bills or notice
- Copy of lease
- Financial Hardship Unemployment etc.



Coverage

 City of Atlanta, Augusta-Richmond, Chatham, Cherokee, Clayton, Cobb, DeKalb, Forsyth, Fulton, Gwinnett, Hall, Henry have received their own funding

Documents for Landlord

- Completed Landlord application
- Proof of ownership/management company
- Copy of lease
- Ledger showing tenant's payment history in 2020 and 2021
- W-9 and bank information for ACH

DCA Coverage

DCA will provide assistance in the balance of state and in these counties at a later date.



Rent Assistance

• Up to 12 months including arrears and future payments
