

## \$63,839,335

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



- ADAP = 60%

- ADAP Supplemental = 16%




# FY 2020-21 Ryan White Part B/COVID-19 Allocation \$1,161,513

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
# Georgia Ryan White Part B/ADAP Program Allocation (Millions)

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


# Georgia Clients Served in Ryan White Part B Clinics

# AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) and Health Insurance Continuation Program (HICP) Update

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The Georgia AIDS Drug Assistance Program provides HIV/AIDS and Hep C medications to low-income individuals living with HIV disease, who have little or no coverage from private or third-party insurance



# AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP) and Health Insurance Continuation Program (HICP) Update

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The Georgia ADAP provides medications for the treatment of HIV/AIDS to eligible Georgia residents

- There are 28 ADAP/HICP enrollment sites
- The ADAP enrollment was 9,670 as of May 31, 2020
- Currently serving 6,860 ending May 31, 2020; (utilization rate was 71% as of May 31, 2020)

# ADAP/HICP Additional Updates . . .

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There are 72 medications on the formulary inclusive of all required classes

There are 7 additional medications under Hep C Program

- The Hep C enrollment was 153 as of April 1, 2020



ADAP Contract Pharmacy (ACP) Network currently comprised of 20 pharmacies located throughout the state including 3 statewide delivery pharmacies

All ADAP clients currently receive their medication through the ACP

# ADAP/HICP Additional Updates . . .

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The Health Insurance Continuation Program (HICP) assists eligible persons with active insurance policies who are unable to pay their health insurance premiums

- The HICP enrollment was 1,842 as of May 31, 2020
- Pays up to \$1,788 monthly premium
