## RULES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH

## CHAPTER 511-2-1 NOTIFICATION OF DISEASE

## 511-2-1-.05 Pilot Study for the Reporting of Pediatric Asthma Deaths.

- (1) It shall be the duty of every physician, coroner, and medical examiner that attends or examines the remains of a patient under the age of 18 years old in circumstances indicating that asthma was or may have been the cause of or a contributing factor to death to report that death to the Department. It is the intent of this Rule that only one report shall be made for a particular patient, and there shall be no duty to report if a complete and accurate report has already been made by another physician, coroner, or medical examiner who has examined the patient.
- (2) Reports shall be made to the Department within ten days of death or examination, through an online portal set up for that purpose.
- (3) This Rule shall be effective for deaths occurring on or after the effective date of this Rule, and shall remain in effect until 31 December 2018 unless extended.
