Dietetic Internship Program

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Policy

WIC employees meeting degree, work performance, work experience, and district support requirements may be eligible to apply for admission to the Georgia Department of Public Health's WIC Dietetic Internship Program in order to complete the core competencies for Registered Dietitians through supervised practice.

Purpose

The Dietetic Internship Program's primary goal is to achieve improved health outcomes of Georgians through the promotion of quality nutrition care practice by assisting qualified employees of the Georgia Department of Public Health's WIC Program to become Registered Dietitians.
