
Georgia Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) Monthly Report—October 2019


What is the PDMP? The PDMP is an electronic database used to collect, monitor, and analyze prescribing and dispensing data about controlled substances (such as opioids, benzodiazepines and stimulants) in Georgia. The PDMP collects details of every Schedule II – V prescription drug order dispensed in Georgia. The purpose of this report is to describe opioid prescribing patterns in Georgia on a monthly basis. From 2017 to 2018, the number of opioid prescriptions decreased by 6% and benzodiazepine prescriptions also decreased by 3%. Stimulant prescriptions increased by 12%.

Over the past year, the average number of opioid, benzodiazepine, and stimulant prescriptions dispensed each month has trended downward.









Age-Adjusted Opioid Prescription Rate by County, Georgia - October 2019
