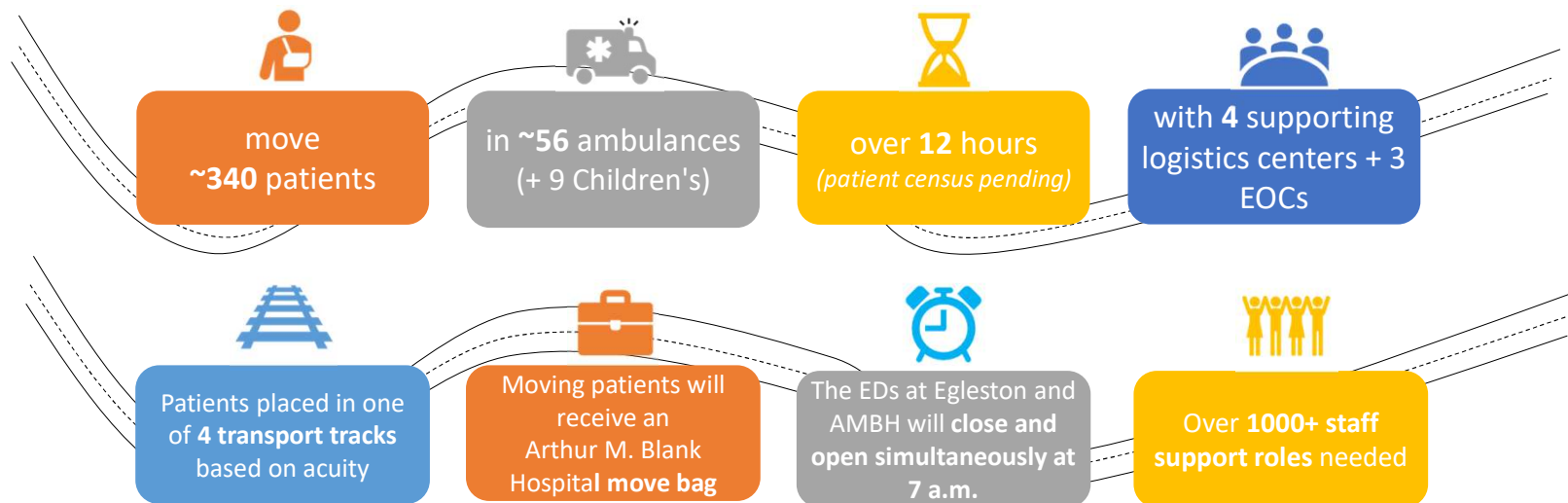

Prior to Move Day

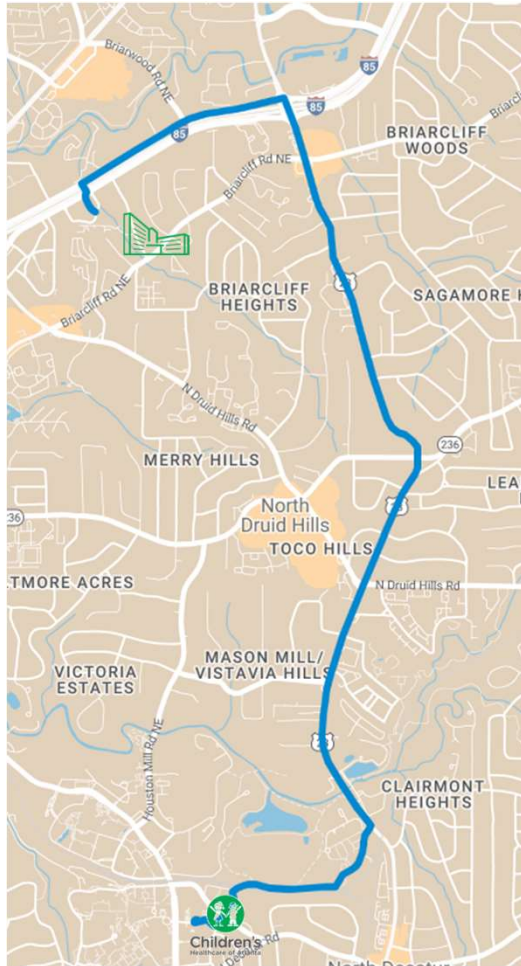
Egleston Hospital and Arthur M. Blank Hospital will be on the following diversion schedule:

- Trauma patients should be diverted to Scottish Rite—if clinically appropriate and capacity allows—from 7 a.m. Sept. 28 to 7 p.m. Sept. 29.
 - Exceptions include patients with penetrating chest injuries. These patients will be accepted at Egleston until Sept. 29 at 7 a.m. and at Arthur M. Blank Hospital starting Sept. 29 after 7 a.m.
- ECMO will go on diversion to external facilities Sept. 28 at 7 a.m. to Sept. 29 at 7 p.m.
- Emergency Department will be on diversion Sept. 29 at 3 a.m. to Sept. 29 at 7 p.m.
 - EMS should divert all pediatric emergency and trauma patients—as appropriate—to Scottish Rite or Hughes Spalding Hospitals on Sept. 29

EMS Entrance

Primary EMS access

1 From I-85 South to North Druid Hills Road

- Take Exit 89 for GA-42 S/North Druid Hills Road.
- Turn left off exit ramp onto North Druid Hills Road.
- Turn left at the traffic light to I-85 Frontage Road.
- Turn right into Children's North Druid Hills campus as indicated on the map. There will be a blue "Ambulance" monument sign designating the entrance.
- Follow the blue "Ambulance" directional signs.

2 From I-85 North

- Take Exit 89 for GA-42 S/North Druid Hills Road.
- Follow the exit ramp to GA-42 S/North Druid Hills Road.
- Cross over GA-42 S/North Druid Hills Road to I-85 Frontage Road.
- Turn right into Children's North Druid Hills campus as indicated on the map. There will be a blue "Ambulance" monument sign designating the entrance.
- Follow the blue "Ambulance" directional signs.



EMS Entrance

Secondary EMS access

3 From I-85 South to Clairmont Road

- Take Exit 91 for US 23/GA-155/Clairmont Road/Decatur.
- Follow the signs to Access Road South/North Druid Hills Road. You will cross over Clairmont Road at the traffic light.
- Continue straight on I-85 Frontage Road (1.5 miles).
- Using the center lane, turn left at the I-85 underpass and follow the signs towards Cliff Valley Way/Access Road North.
- At the traffic light, go straight to enter the Children's campus.
- Follow the blue "Ambulance" directional signs.



EMS Entrance

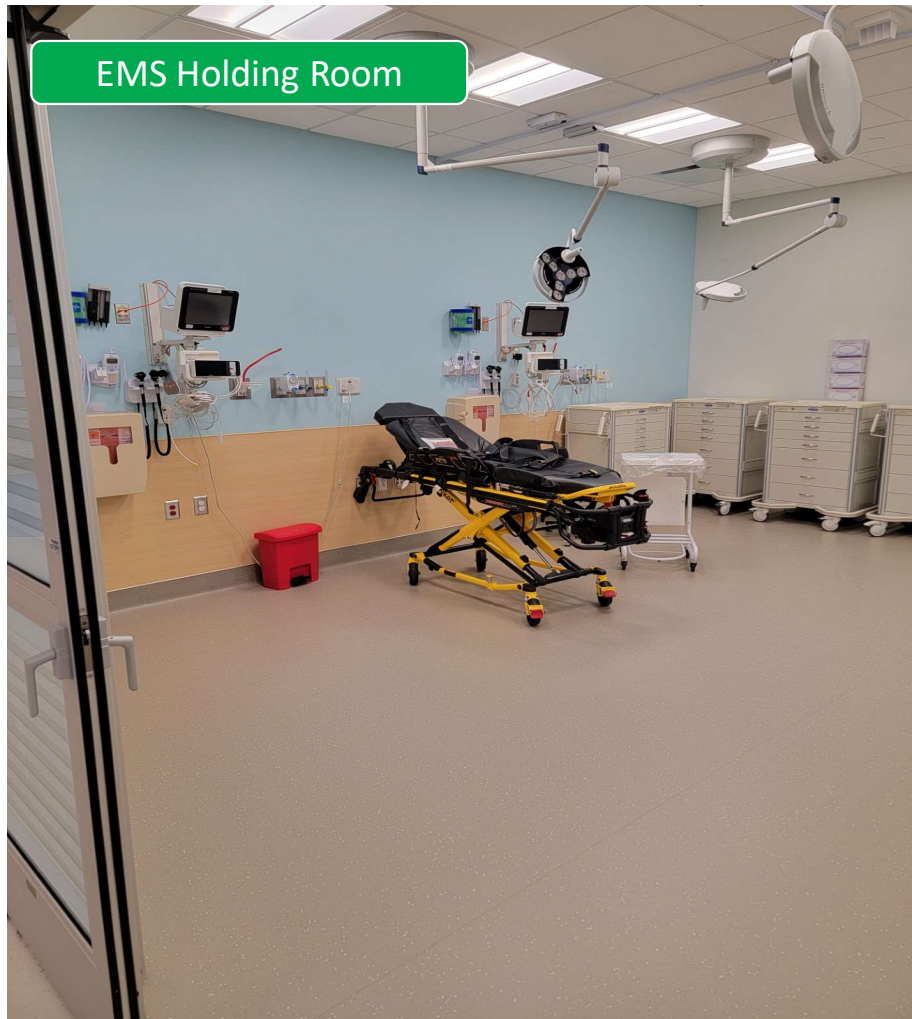
- * Dedicated EMS entrance to pull-through ambulance bay
- * As you approach the Emergency Department gate, our license plate reader will recognize your vehicle's license plate and the gate will open automatically.
- * If the gate does not automatically open, use Click2Open or press the intercom button to notify Security.



Ambulance Bay

- * Designated EMS work room with seating where you can plug in your computer
- * Located directly inside EMS entrance
- * Water and ice dispenser
- * LSB storage



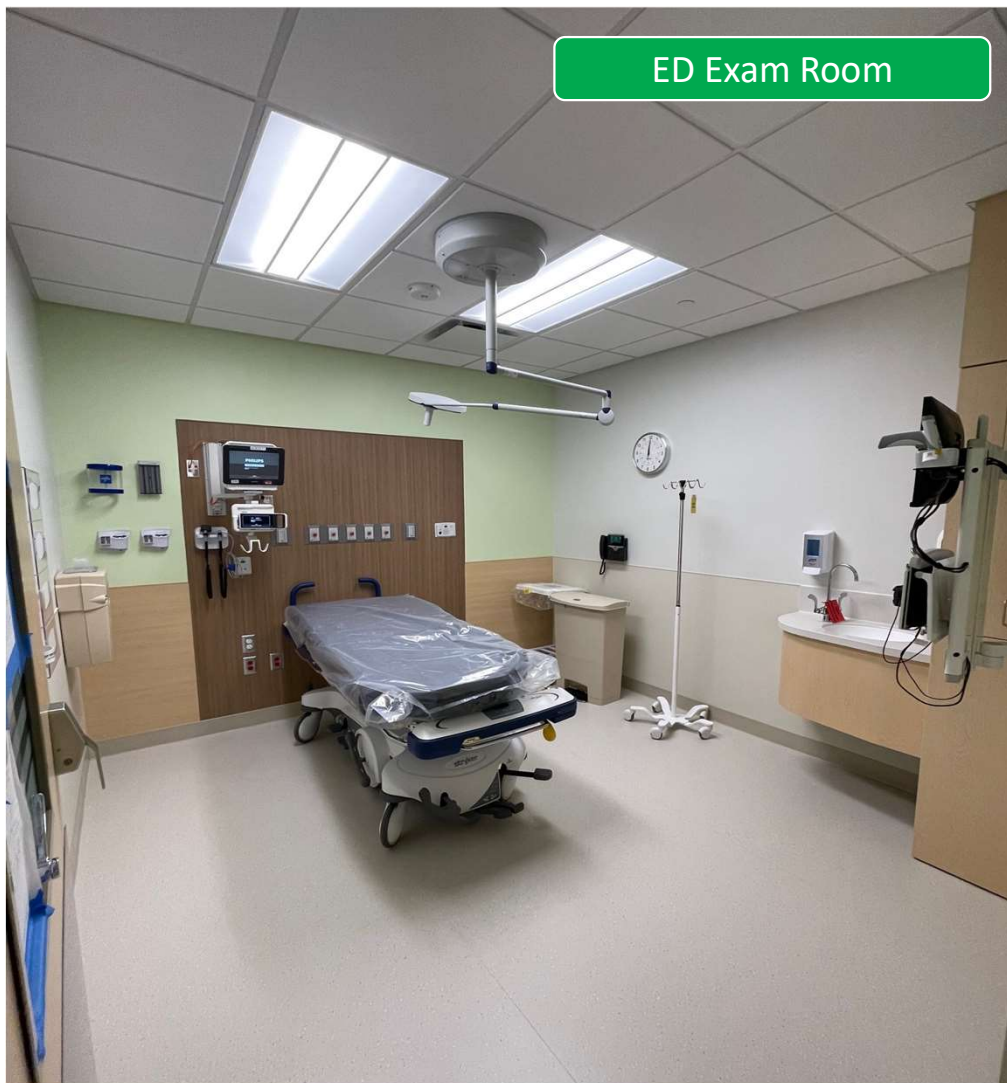


No more "holding the wall..."

- If a room is not available, crews can quickly give report to an RN, and offload their patient, getting back into service quicker.
- Able to monitor 4 patients
- Will have designated EMS Holding RN

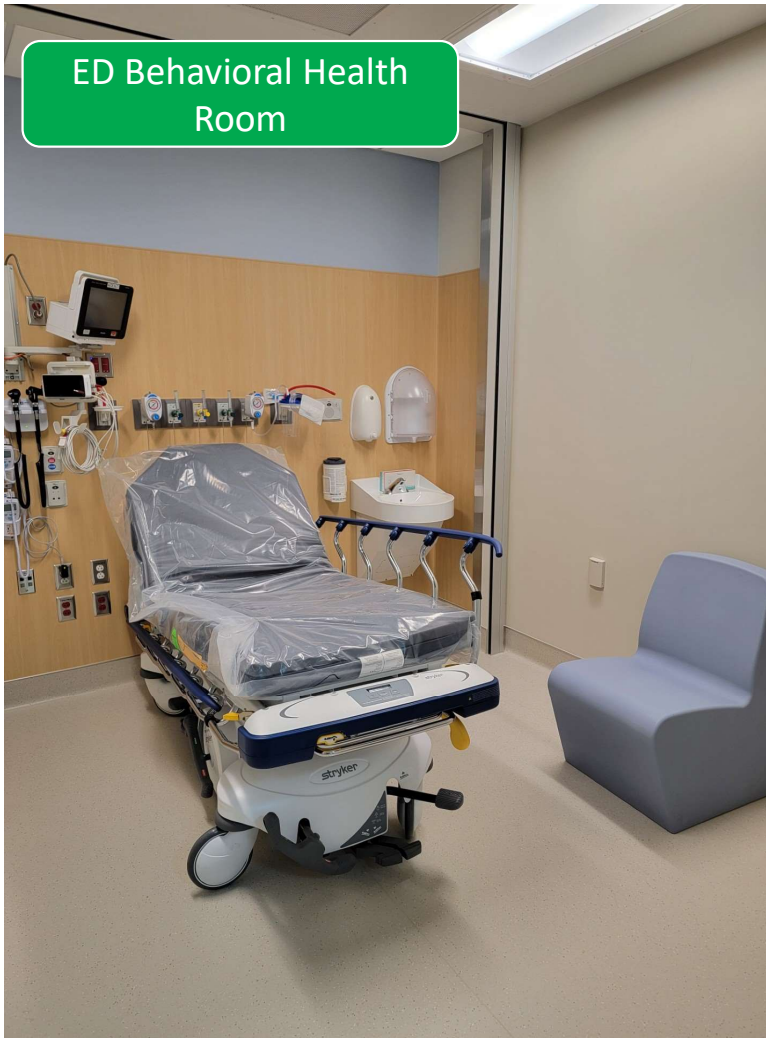
Trauma Room 1 of 6





ED Exam Room

- 63 total exam rooms, with the ability to flex to 100 rooms as needed
- 25% larger than rooms at Egleston



ED Behavioral Health Room

- Dedicated locked unit for Behavioral Health patients
- All rooms are ligature-free with weighted furniture
- Garage door for monitoring equipment
- Each room has video monitoring capability

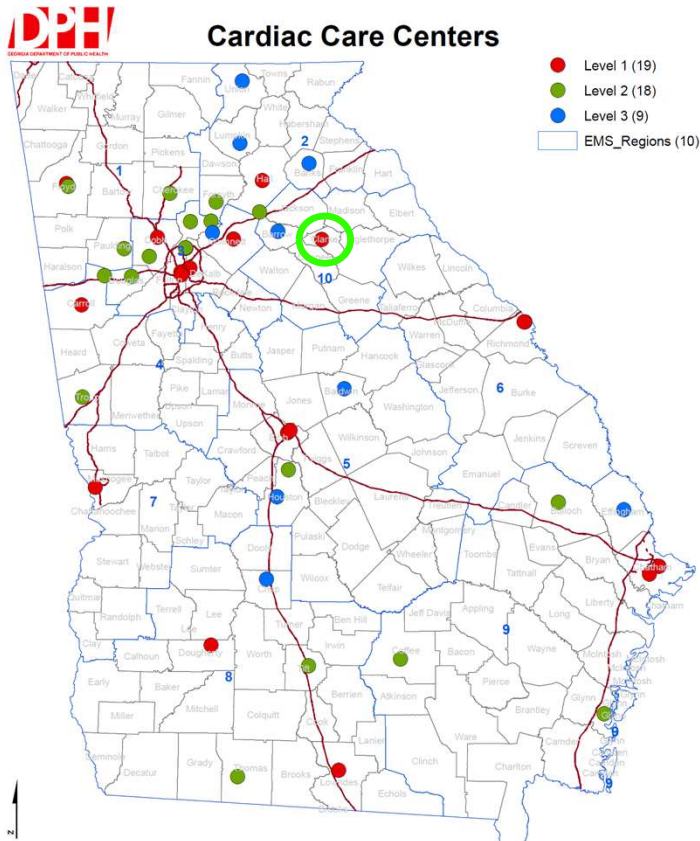

- License renewal fee, \$75.00, Late fee, \$75.00 (Credit Card fee \$2.75)

This is the LATE medic renewal license for all medics (EMT, EMT-I, AEMT, CT, Paramedic) in Georgia. The late renewal phase = 6 months post-license expiration. The Late Renewal fee is \$75.00 in addition to the license renewal fee.	

EMT-Responder License Renewal (146) (9/30/2024)

Renewal Application: **Georgia EMT-R Renewal**

EMT-R Renewal Requirements:

- Sixteen (16) hours CE (Dept approved/Dept recognized)
 - Modules & hour requirements specified in current EMR National Continued Competency Program (NCCP) specified by NREMT
 - Continuing Education (CE) must be entered into Education Report into LMS
- Current CPR/BCLS certification
- Current EMR certification through NREMT
 - Prior to renewal of EMT-R license, the licensee's certification through the NREMT shall be renewed.
- License renewal fee, \$75.00 (Credit Card fee \$2.75)

Renewal Application will close on **September 30th** for those that expire **2024**

Voucher Codes

Voucher codes available in LMS (\$75/\$25):

- Medic Initial/Renewal application
- Initial/Renewal Instructor License application

Purchased voucher codes:

- Should be treated like a credit card/cash
- Can be used for partial payment of license fee.
- Can be applied for a license fee, any balance left on the voucher is not transferable. (The voucher code can only be used once).
- No expiration date
- Non-refundable
- Can be used on any personnel (Medic/Instructor) license application
- Non-transferrable by OEMST

Application to use:

- Order Voucher Codes

Voucher Code Process

- Agency submits application to order voucher codes
- Invoice will be emailed to Agency
- Once payment by check is received in the Department
- Voucher codes will be emailed to Agency
- Agency distributes or assigns voucher code to personnel

Voucher Code Application will close at end of the day on February 28, 2024

Schematron Update (effective 9/29/2024)

Validation Rules **Revised** (Schematron Update eff. 10/01/2024)

- Vascular Access Location (eProcedures.13) is required (Rule 924)
 - Rule will not fire when Vascular Access Location = a PN of Contraindication Noted, Denied by Order & Refused
- Procedure Successful (eProcedures.06) is required when procedure performed (Rule 3838)
 - Rule will now accept a PN of Contraindication Noted, Denied by Order & Refused

Type of Service Requested (eResponse.05)

Definition: The type of service or category of service requested of the EMS Agency responding for this specific EMS event.

Emergency Response (Primary Response Area)/ 911 Response (Scene)

- Emergent/immediate response to an incident location (e.g., 9-1-1, walk-in, flagging down, air ambulance scene flight)
- Note: Emergency response does not mean that the unit had a lights/sirens response.

- Emergent (Immediate Response)
- Emergent Downgraded to Non-Emergent
- Non-Emergent
- Non-Emergent Upgraded to Emergent

Additional Response Mode Descriptors (eResponse.24)

The documentation of response mode techniques used for this EMS response.

(May have more than 1 selection)

- Scheduled
- Unscheduled
- Lights & Sirens
- No Lights & Sirens
- Initial Lights & Sirens, Downgraded to No Lights & Sirens
- Initial No Lights & Sirens, Upgraded to Lights & Sirens

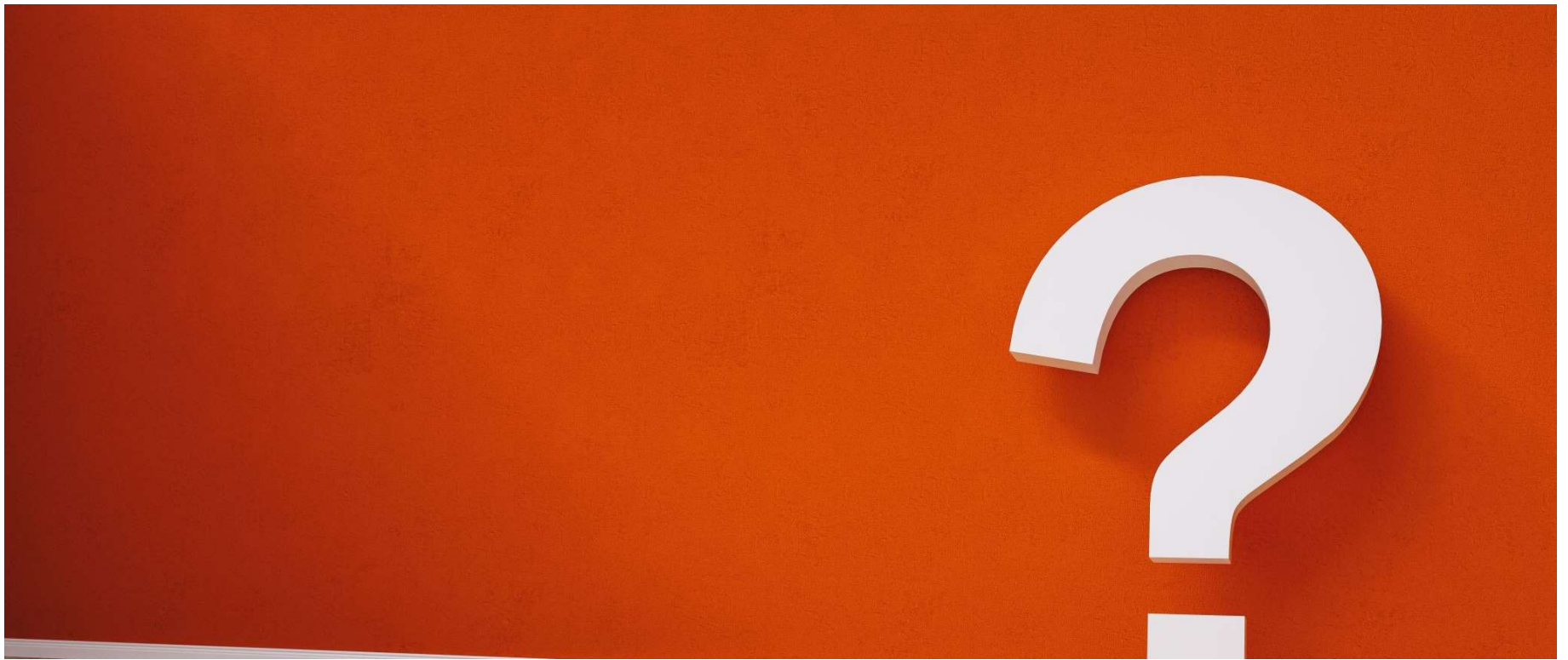
