



## EMS Personnel License Renewal

### Personnel License Renewal

### Georgia Medic Renewal application available until March 31, 2024.

- Continuing Education (CE) must be entered into Education Report into LMS
- Must upload BCLS and ACLS (if applicable) cards inside the renewal application
- License renewal fee, \$75.00 (Credit Card fee \$2.75)



### Instructions for Entering CE hours into Education Report

#### How to Submit Continuing Education Hours During the Renewal Cycle

Please note - if you attend an OEMS course - before you add training yourself, please check to see if the instructor has already added you to the course.

#### If you have

- Go to <a href="https://www.mygemsis.org/lms/public/">https://www.mygemsis.org/lms/public/</a> and log in (click <a href="https://www.mygemsis.org/lms/public/">HERE</a> for instructions on how to obtain access)
- 2. Click on Education on the left
- 3. Click on My Report under the Education link
- On this tab, you will see any courses that you have already added (or have been added by you attending an OEMS approved course)
  - a. Click on the (>) next to each topic to see the list of courses that have been already put on your training record and verify that is not already been added.
- 5. For each training course/date that you are wanting to add, do the following:
  - a. Click on the green (+) button to the right of one of the topics that the training you are adding is included
  - b. Enter the Course Name of the training (you do not need to enter the course number)
  - c. Enter the Completed Date of the course (if the course was multiple dates, enter the last date of the course)
  - d. You do not need to enter the Location
  - Upload a scanned copy of your course certificate by clicking the Choose File button, and selecting the file on your computer for your certificate.
  - f. Based on which green (+) button you click, the first topic has been selected for you (enter the number of hours)
  - g. To add additional topics, Click Add Topic, Select the Topic, and Enter the number of hours of credit (remember that you must have 40 hours - with at least 4 in Trauma, 4 in Cardiac, and 8 in Pediatrics)
    - To enter additional topics covered for this training course/day, click Add Topic
    - · When you are done adding topics, click the blue Add button
- 6. Your hours have been added!

### EMS Instructor and Instructor/Coordinator LATE Renewal

Instructors or Instructor/Coordinators with 12/31/2023 expiration date

Late Renewal period is now open until June 30th, 2024

CE and Active Teaching will be accepted from day after license issue date – 06/30/2024

License late renewal fee, \$50.00 (Credit Card fee \$2.75)

### Voucher Codes

### **Voucher Codes**

- Voucher codes now available in LMS:
  - Medic Renewal application
  - Initial/Renewal Instructor License application
- Current voucher amounts: \$75.00 and \$25.00
- Purchased voucher codes:
  - Should be treated like a credit card/cash
  - Can be used for partial payment of license fee.
  - Can be applied for a license fee, any balance left on the voucher is not transferable. (The voucher code can only be used once).
  - No expiration date
  - Non-refundable
  - Can be used on any personnel (Medic/Instructor) license application
  - Non-transferrable by OEMST

## Agency Pay for Medic Renewal (Voucher Codes)

- All Agency pay for Medic/Instructor licensure (Initial and Renewal) will be done by voucher codes.
  - This will be a phased in process of the new voucher code system starting with Medic Renewals.
  - No new voucher codes will be issued for initial license applications until Phase 3 of this transition.
- LMS can now internally generate and recognize voucher codes for medic license payments.
  - LMS generated voucher code process will be a phased in approach
  - Phase 1 Medic Renewals
  - Phase 2 Initial/Renewal Instructor Licensure
  - Phase 3 Initial Medic Licensure


## Agency Pay – Voucher Codes

- Application to use for Medic License Renewal/Initial Instructor voucher codes:
  - Order Voucher Codes application
- Voucher Code Process
  - Agency submits application to order voucher codes
  - Invoice will be emailed to Agency
  - Once payment by check is received in the Department
  - Voucher codes will be emailed to Agency
  - Agency will distribute voucher code to personnel
  - Medic will complete Georgia Medic Renewal application
    - Payment tab: Select Voucher Code
    - Once application submitted, Medic will enter voucher code in payment screen








## Georgia EMS Patch

# Rule 511-9-2-.15. General Provisions for Emergency Medical Services Personnel, EMS Instructors, and EMS Instructor/Coordinators

- (1) Emergency Medical Services Personnel shall at all times while on duty wear visible identification, to include name, company name and license level and may include the State EMS patch or embroidered facsimile, along with license level rocker. Patches of other licensing agencies are not an acceptable substitute.
- (2) Emergency Medical Services Personnel shall at all times while on duty have a government issued photo identification on their person.

## Naloxone for EMS Agencies

- 2024-Q2 EMS Naloxone Distribution
  - Request Application will open on February 12<sup>th</sup>
  - Application will close on March 1<sup>st</sup>

## EMS Agency License Fees

- Beginning January 1, 2024, there will no longer be EMS agency license fees.
- The vehicle **re-inspection fee** will continue.
  - o 1st re-inspection due to failed inspection \$150.00
  - Any 2<sup>nd</sup> or subsequent re-inspections due to failed inspections \$250.00
- Any license fees due in 2023 will still need to be paid.
- EMS Agency license renewal application will still be required.
  - Agencies will no longer receive annual (Anniversary) payment/application notification beginning 2024

- Medical Director(s)
- Pharmacy(s)
- Personnel
- Vehicles
- Locations
- Key Personnel

## GEMSIS Elite v3.5 Transition - Update

- Thank you for working hard and transitioning on time to NEMSIS v3.5!
- Georgia was the 24<sup>th</sup> state in the nation to implement the newest NEMSIS EMS data standard.
- Housekeeping Items....
  - Data Managers and/or EMS Agency Administrators for <u>ALL</u> licensed EMS Agencies are required to log in to GEMSIS Elite on a daily and/or weekly basis to review the data submitted.
  - ePCRs must be submitted to GEMSIS Elite within 24 hours of call completion.
  - If you are a new Data Manager and/or EMS Agency Administrator for an agency and do not have access to GEMSIS Elite. Please contact us for account setup.
- New Schematron file coming soon!
  - Revised v3.5 validation rules
  - Updated facilities list (new facilities added)



## PCR Documentation: Non-Transporting Responder


### MFR, QRV, etc. Non-Transporting Responder PCRs:

- Do not document the Name of the Facility the patient is being transported to by Ambulance crew in Destination/Transferred To, Name (eDisposition.01)
- These PCRs are showing up in Hospital Hub and Patient Registry and if the ambulance has changed the patient's destination:
  - A hospital that did not receive the patient, has a patient record that did not come to their facility.
  - The hospital that the patient did get transported to, will not be able to access the PCR through the linkage in the Hospital Hub system.

## Hospital Hub

- Linkage of PCRs in Hospital Hub is based on:
  - Patient First Name
  - Patient Last Name
  - Date of Birth
  - Gender
  - Within 72 hours of transporting PCR

Does your PCR system have the ability to scan the Driver's License for patient demographic information?





## **SOP Changes**

- •Added ETC02 monitoring and interpretation to the AEMT level.
- Added Vascular Monitoring and Interpretation (Doppler)
- •Added Glucagon via Auto-Injector to EMT and EMT-I level.
- Added POCUS for peripheral (extremity) IV insertion.
- •Separated CPAP/BiPAP and added CPAP to EMT
- Added Cyanokit to AEMT
- •Added non-narcotic/non-controlled analgesics to AEMT
- •Added antiemetics (Zofran) via parenteral and OTD route to AEMT


