



Georgia Flu Snapshot ("Minimal" Activity)




- Flu activity declined steadily since November and is now MINIMAL (3 on a scale of 1-13)
- The proportion of outpatient visits for ILI in GA has been under 3% (below baseline) for 7 weeks. This is unusual, we usually just begin to see flu declines in March.
- All season, 95% of viruses have been Flu A, most (64%) A H3N2; but last week we saw 70% Flu A and 30% Flu B (B is higher than last month).

Georgia Flu Snapshot, by Age Group




- All season long, the number of outpatient visits for ILI has been consistently highest (64% of total) among the young—age groups 0-4 and 5-24 years.
- We see only 8% of outpatient visits among those >65, but we do see most hospitalizations (37%) and deaths (70%) here (32/46).


Influenza Deaths, Georgia, 2022-2023 Season



We have confirmed 46 flu deaths this season; 70% (32/46) were older than 65 and 1 was in a child 5-17


COVID Landscape





This week, COVID cases dropped by 24%, COVID hospitalizations decreased by 31%, and COVID deaths decreased by 37%. The daily average of COVID cases was down to 478. We have not seen daily case counts under 500 since early April 2022.

COVID Landscape

- Caution is always warranted, because testing numbers are down, not all cases are reported, immunity wanes, and even though XBB.1.5 represents nearly all COVID cases (90%+), new variants can continue to emerge.
- Overall, the immunity "wall" appears to be protecting against surges, and especially severe outcomes, so bivalent boostering is still critical

Georgia Medic Renewal application available until March 31, 2023.

- Continuing Education (CE) must be entered into Education Report into LMS
- Must upload BCLS and ACLS (if applicable) cards inside the renewal application

Common Questions/Issues

- Medics are uploading the education documents of verification to the Documents Section and not through the Education Report.
- Traffic Incident Management Course only has to be completed once.
- Georgia Medic Renewal-Agency Paid application
- If the course is taken on TRAIN Georgia the CE will be uploaded to your Education Report manually by the OEMST staff.
 - Starting March 10th, this will be done once a day
 - Your medic number MUST be correct in TRAIN or the upload will not process



All Agency System Administrators need to confirm that all Medic credentials are entered correctly in your ePCR software systems.

Documenting Correct Medic License Numbers

- eCrew.01 the license number
- Must be properly formatted single letter and then 6-digit number left padded with 0s (zeroes) these are not the letter "O"
 - R###### (i.e. R001234)
 - E###### (i.e. E001234)
 - I###### (i.e. I023456)
 - A###### (i.e. A003456)
 - C###### (i.e. C000012)
 - P###### (i.e. P005678)
- Should match the license level (eCrew.02)
- Should be updated when a medic gets a new license
- This is NOT the National Registry number.
