




### PCR Cases Over Time (By date of report)



Confirmed Deaths by Date of Report



# Confirmed Deaths by Date of **Death**







#### Medic Renewals


- Medic Renewal application open for those that expire 3/31/2022, closes 3/31/2022, 11:59pm
- Medic Renewal-Agency Paid application paid by the agency for a medic renewal expires 3/31/2022, closes 3/31/2022, 11:59pm
- Agency Pay for Medic Renewal application no longer open (was open until 2/15/2022)
- Already renewed = 3,139
- $\circ$  Still to renew = 3,979

# Agency Paying for a Medic Renewal

- Applications from the agency were due on 2/15/2022
- Agency Pay for Medic Renewal Applications:
  - $_{\mbox{\scriptsize o}}$  Medics should NOT wait to enter their CEUs (education) into LMS
  - Payments not received before COB (5pm) on Thursday, 3/31/2022 will not be processed
  - Once payment is received, medics will need to complete the renewal process on their own
  - Medics will **not** see the agency paid renewal application until the agency payment is received

### Late Medic Renewal

- ALL renewals completed after 3/31/2022 will be a Late Medic Renewal
  - o Late Georgia Medic Renewal application
  - o Will include a late fee of \$75.00
  - $_{\rm o}$  Agency paid fees will not be credited to a Late Medic Renewal application
  - $\circ$  Late medic renewal period: 04/01/22 09/30/22

# Emergency Rule

Emergency Rule 511-9-2-0.5 containing Rule 511-9-2-0.5-.12 entitled "Temporary Licenses and License Reinstatements for Emergency Medical Services Personnel for COVID-19 Response"

Rule became effective on 1/28/2022 Rule is effective till **5/27/2022** (120 days total)

Addresses EMS workforce related items:

- Temporary Compact License
- Reinstatements

### Temporary Compact License

A license at the EMT, AEMT, or Paramedic level that is issued by the Department to a person who holds a current EMS license in good standing, including remote state privilege to practice, in another member state of the Interstate Commission for EMS Personnel Practice ("Compact").

License is good for 120 days (one-time at the respective application level)

Allows those medics to quickly begin working in Georgia while allowing them time (120 days) to gain full licensure.

#### Reinstatements

#### Requirements:

- Previous Georgia non-provisional and non-temporary medic license
- License was in good standing when the license lapsed for failure to renew between March 31, 2019 and March 31, 2021.
- Eligible = 4,911

### Issued So Far

Temporary Compact Licenses = None yet

Reinstatements (since this new Emergency Rule): N=32

- EMT = 13
- EMT-Intermediate = 6
- AEMT = 7
- Paramedic = 6

NEMSIS is a collaborative system to improve patient care through the standardization, aggregation, and utilization of point of care EMS data at a local, state and national level. NEMSIS is a product of NHTSA's Office of EMS and in collaboration with the University of Utah is the host of the Technical Assistance Center (TAC).
