

Examples of Yellow Dot EMS Pre- and Post-Test Questions

Here is a sampling of the types of questions found in the Georgia Yellow Dot Program's pre- and post-knowledge tests for emergency medical service providers.

1. If called to a car crash, where do you look for a Yellow Dot *sticker on the car*?
