Provider Trip Report Procedure

Program Overview

Georgia's Yellow Dot Program is a free program that may help save lives. When seconds count, make sure first responders have the information they need.



Program Procedure for EMS/first responders

When responding to an EMS call, either for a motor vehicle crash or a home emergency, the first responders should check for yellow dot decal and/or yellow dot packet folder.

On vehicles, look for the yellow dot decal on the rear driver-side window. The packet will be in the glove compartment.

In the home, the decal will be on the door of the home or the refrigerator of the home. The packet will be on the front, side, or top of the refrigerator.

Procedure: When completing your trip report, please use one of the following phrases at the end of your narrative:

1. Yellow Dot (YD) Found – Used
 - a. Indicates that you found the decal, found a packet (s), and used some of the information in the packet
2. Yellow Dot (YD) Found – Not used
 - a. Indicates that you found the decal, found a packet (s), but did **not** use the packet information
3. Yellow Dot (YD) Decal found – no yellow dot packet
 - a. Indicates that you located a decal, but there was no packet

These phrases will help us track the implementation of the program.
