Overview of Data Requested

- 1. All NHSN data included in the Hospital Quality Reporting Program
- 2. Start date is January 2013
 - Not retrospective
- 3. Includes 2012 survey
 - Survey data available as of January 2013

Additional Identifiers Requested

To assist with future validation efforts:

- 1. Requesting gender and date of birth
 - Required fields; no additional data entry
- 2. Request Patient ID be input as Medical Record Number
 - Supports NHSN relational database structure

Details of Data Requested

Included with letter from Commissioner to hospital leadership:

STATE OF GEORGIA SUMMARY OF DATA REQUEST

1. General (applies to all facility types)

- · Patient with specific identifiers: gender and DOB
- · Monthly reporting plan
- Data Analysis
- Facility Information (facility ID, name and contact)



Overview of Conferring Rights

- 1. Hospitals confer rights by January 31, 2013.
- 2. Confer rights for data required by CMS.
 - Critical Access Hospitals can participate as well.
- 3. Group ID = 29283
- 4. Password = giamrs812!
- 5. Confer rights under Patient Safety <u>and</u> Healthcare Personnel Modules


Details of Conferring Rights


From left navigation bar, select Group→Join






Part I: Confer Rights--Patient Safety

Review list of Conferred Rights and Scroll to bottom and select "Accept"




Part II: Confer Rights--Healthcare Personnel (HCP) Safety (1 of 4)

Log onto Healthcare Personnel Safety Module




Part II: Confer Rights: HCP Safety Continued (2 of 4)

An Action Item will appear to confer rights. Select the "not accepted" link.




Part II: Confer Rights: HCP Safety Continued (3 of 4)

The Confer Rights Not Accepted screen will appear. Select "State of Georgia."



Part II: Confer Rights: HCP Safety Continued (Part 4 of 4)

The Confer Rights-HCP Safety Screen will appear. Scroll to bottom and select "Accept."



Frequently Asked Question (FAQ) 1

What if an HAI is not applicable to our facility, such as we do not have a NICU or we do not perform HYST? Do I still need to confer rights for non-applicable measures?

Under the heading "your locations," you will see "no locations meets criteria." If you do not have the specified location, it is fine to accept as presented. You can confer rights for that item and the state will not receive any information because your facility will not enter data for it.

FAQ 2

I am tracking HYST inpatient and outpatient procedures. Will my outpatient HYST data be viewed by the state?

No. The state is requesting only inpatient procedures at this time, and if your facility is tracking inpatient and outpatient HYST procedures, the confer rights template will only allow the state to view the inpatient HYST procedures.

FAQ 3

If the Confer Rights page does not appear or if I need to review it again, how can I do so?

From left navigation bar, select Group → Confer Rights. Highlight "State of Georgia" in the box on right and select gray "Confer Rights" button. A dialog box will appear stating it is a facility's decision to confer rights; select "OK." The conferring rights screen will appear.
