Asthma Education and Home Visiting Program

Asthma Education and Home Visiting is a **NO COST** program for the families of children with uncontrolled asthma. A trained nurse will help patients learn how to address asthma triggers at home, reduce asthma symptoms, and correctly use asthma medications.

Who Is Eligible?

A person may be eligible to participate in the Asthma Education and Home Visiting Program if <u>ALL</u> of the following requirements are met:

- Live in Macon or Augusta Health District
- Is 0 17 years of age
- Enrolled in Children's Medical Services
- Enrolled in Medicaid
- Has a diagnosis of asthma
- Speaks English

What Services Are Offered?

- Asthma education to families (i.e. symptoms, triggers, prevention, medication, etc)
- In-home inspection for asthma triggers (i.e. mold, pests, etc)
- Referrals for housing, health care services, etc.



- Reduce asthma symptoms
- Reduce asthma triggers at home
- Learn how to correctly use asthma medication
- Learn the benefits of an asthma action plan
- Miss fewer days of school and work
- Reduce unwanted doctor visit and hospitalizations
