Application Project Guidelines

1. Consult with your Supervisor, Clinic Manager, and/or the Nutrition Services Director in your district to determine an issue of interest in WIC. Examples:
 - District or clinic first trimester enrollment is below the standard.
 - District or clinic child enrollment has declined over the past year.
 - Last audit indicated district or clinic primary or secondary nutrition education rates below standard, etc.
2. Compile a brief literature review highlighting implications of and solutions to the issue as found in peer reviewed research.
3. Using appropriate data sources and methods, identify trends and determine cause(s).
4. Create an APA style report to include methods of data collection and analysis, findings to include results with graphical representations of data, discussion, and a plan of intervention.
5. Submit the completed report with your internship application packet by the required deadline.
